



CodiAC Soccer Player / Coaches Code of Conduct



All players, coaches, team officials and parent volunteers associated with the competitive or recreational program are ambassadors of CodiAC Soccer and agree to conform to the following minimum criteria:

- The team shall conduct itself in a manner so as to enhance the reputation of CodiAC Soccer.
- The team shall have and maintain a satisfactory discipline record as determined by the Board of Directors of CodiAC Soccer.
- The team shall consistently meet its financial and reporting obligations to CodiAC Soccer in a timely manner.
- While away, the team shall behave as a guest should and shall not have attempted to embarrass or otherwise demean its host or act in any way which would serve to bring CodiAC Soccer into disrepute.
- As a host team, the team shall have carried out its duties in exemplary manner.
- The team shall honour all of its commitments as they relate to scheduling and shall not have forfeited or defaulted on any of its obligations to any league or tournaments in which it may be entered.
- The team shall have consistently supported game and league officials, addressed any complaints in a timely manner, and ensured that appropriate corrective actions has been taken in respect to those complaints.
- Players must conduct themselves in a respectful manner in relations with opposing players, match officials or spectators. This expected standard of behaviour extends to the use of social media before or after a match.
- Fines incurred as a result of disciplinary decisions by governing regional, provincial or national bodies will be the sole responsibility of the team in question.

The use of social media to taunt, threaten, or bully any player, coach, official, or spectator is strictly prohibited. Violation of CodiAC Soccer's Social Media Policy or Code of Conduct will be subject to disciplinary action as determined by CodiAC Soccer's Disciplinary Committee.

Any player, coach, team official or member who acts in a manner detrimental to CSI or in violation of the Constitution, the by-laws and any rules which may be from time to time adopted by CSI shall be subject to disciplinary action. Codiac Soccer Spectator Code of Conduct

The aim of the Codiac Soccer Code of Conduct is to promote a safe, positive and fun soccer environment for everyone. Codiac Soccer is committed to upholding the Code of Conduct for its players, volunteer coaches and spectators. In cases where players or coaches do not follow the principles and rules of the Code of Conduct, Codiac Soccer will continue to follow established club and league disciplinary procedures.

In cases where spectators do not follow the principles and rules of the Code of Conduct, Codiac Soccer has adopted the following club disciplinary procedures.

First occurrence Any person who displays behaviour contrary to the Code of Conduct will be issued a verbal or written warning by the coach, manager or a representative of the Codiac Board of Directors.

Second occurrence Any person who continues to display such behaviour will be suspended from all club activities for a period of time determined by the Codiac Board of Directors.

Third occurrence Any person who displays such behaviour on a third occasion will be banned from all club activities indefinitely.

In cases of particularly serious incidents, the Codiac Board of Directors may impose immediate suspensions or bans from club activities. The Codiac Board of Directors may also revoke the club registration for players associated with any person who fails to comply with disciplinary measures taken by the club.

Codiac Soccer urges everyone involved in club activities to work together in promoting a safe, positive and fun soccer environment. Upholding our Code of Conduct is a shared responsibility.
