



Process for registering players who will be receiving financial assistance - 2018



Dear parents,

This process has changed for 2018

Regardless of what funding organization you may be applying to, confirmation that an application has been made must be received by CodiAC Soccer before your child will be placed on a team. In the case of First Touch (competitive) players, the confirmation form must be received before your child is permitted to try out for a team.

Jumpstart

If you are applying to Jumpstart for funding assistance, you should be aware that all applications must now be submitted electronically, and must include proof of income. Families who are not able to apply online for themselves must visit one of the Jumpstart Community Partners for assistance. In order to avoid your child missing the start of the soccer season, it is very important that applications are submitted early. It may take up to a week for the application to be processed and approved. If the application for funding is approved, parents will be given a Jumpstart Submission Number that looks something like NB13547657. That number **MUST** be included on the CodiAC Soccer registration forms. If for any reason, your application for funding assistance is declined, please forward the email that you receive from Jumpstart to codiacsoccer@gmail.com.

Other funding organizations

You are welcome to apply to any organization of your choosing. If you are applying to any organization other than Jumpstart, please forward written documentation of your approval for funding to codiacsoccer@gmail.com.

Parents of First Touch Players: you should be aware that Jumpstart will only cover the cost of the Registration fee. You will be responsible for paying the Tryout and Select fees on your own. If you are applying to an organization other than Jumpstart, please confirm with them which fees they will cover.
